# The Anonymisation Decision Making Framework

#### What is the ADMF?

- A system for developing anonymisation policy.
- A practical tool for understanding your data situation.
- Not a checklist.

## Your responsibility

- 1. Understand how a privacy breach might occur.
- 2. Understand the possible consequences of the breach.
- 3. Reduce the risk of a breach occurring to a negligible level.

## 10 point process

- 1. Describe your data situation
- 2. Understand the legal and governance issues
- 3. Know your data
- 4. Understand the use case
- 5. Meet your ethical obligations
- 6. Identify the processes you will use to assess disclosure risk
- 7. Identify the disclosure control processes that are relevant to your data situation
- 8. Identify who your stakeholders are and plan how you will communicate
- 9. Plan what happens next once you have shared or released the data
- 10. Plan what you will do if things go wrong
